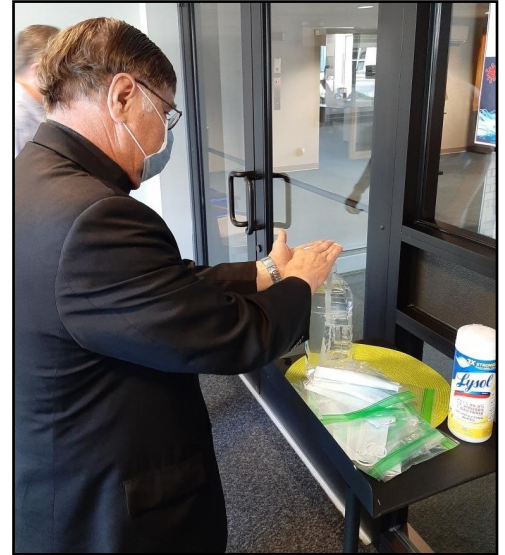


# Worship at St. Stephen's During Covid-19



In accordance with the COVID-19 guidelines, when you enter the building via the front door on Washington Ave., a Greeter (door monitor) takes your temperature, asks you to sanitize your hands, and gives you a mask if you don't have one.



Upon entering the narthex, an Usher escorts you to a seat, self-distancing you from others in alternate pews.



At the end of the service, an Usher escorts you out of the nave.

Because hymnals are not being used, the worship service is printed in the bulletin, including inserts printed with the lyrics to the opening and closing hymns, to which you are invited to hum along, not sing.

And the Psalm, which is read responsively, is also printed on the insert.

For Holy Communion, on the first Sunday of each month, the Usher hands you a ziplock bag with a communion set that includes a wafer and wine or juice.
